AS WE GATHER

We tend to look for things to make faith easier. Signs, wonders, or just little hints here and there would help. Deep within you lies the same faith and longing that sent Peter walking across the wind-swept Sea of Galilee toward Jesus. In what ways is the Lord telling you, as he did Peter, "Come"? Our Risen Lord today calls you to come: Recognize God's presence; discern between faith and foolishness; not only expect problems, but field them when they come; reorient your thoughts about failure and see it as an opportunity to grow; wait on the Lord; And, ultimately, connect more deeply with God.

The choice is yours to know Him as only a water-walker can, aligning yourself with God's purpose for your life in the process. There's just one requirement: *If You Want to Walk on Water, You've Got to Get Out of the Boat*.
